★ ★ ★ Preschool Adventures

This early learning program for children ages 1 - 3 years runs in 9-week sessions on Tuesdays throughout the school year. Activities include crafts, music, movement and snacks. Sessions run 9:30 - 10:30 a.m. and 10:45 - 11:45 a.m. Cost is \$40 per family per session and includes all class materials and snacks.

★ ★ ★ Special Needs Night

Children with special needs have their own special night at the museum. These free sessions are held on the second Thursday of most months from 5:30 - 7:30. Sessions are open to all children with special needs and their parents or caregivers. Each is led by Special Education professionals and includes a meal, fun activities and the opportunity to network with other families. Reservations required in advance for planning purposes. ★ ★ ★ Fun with Fathers

Held on the third Thursday of most months from 5:00 - 7:30 p.m., this free program is open to all fathers and father figures and their kids. ★ ★ ★ Young Athlete's Program

This 9-week training program is focused on developing athletic abilities and acclimating children ages 2 - 8 years old into sports. It also encourages interaction between children with special needs and those without. Program is held after school and off the museum grounds. Event is FREE but registration is required.
